



Ro Copenhagen Ring Sizes

This page will help you to find a ring size by using an existing ring.

Choose a ring size that fits your finger at room temperature. Print this paper in A4, making sure that the printing scale is set to 100%. This line should be 2 inches/50mm if the print is correct:



Ring sizes are written inside the circles. Place your ring on the size circles below to find which option fits the ring you have placed. If you are between two sizes, the biggest of the two options is recommended.

To ensure the size selection is correct, take a ruler or a caliper and measure the inside diameter of your ring, then compare it to the measurement written below the size circle.

Please note that a ring size may depend on the design of a ring; a wide ring may require a larger size, therefore, order one size larger than you would for a narrow ring. The same goes for stacked rings.
